

Mission: to enhance the wellbeing of children and their families through research, evaluation, and advocacy that informs innovation in maternal-child health services and policy






PPN Pediatric Pandemic Network

The Pediatric Pandemic Network (PPN) aims to ensure high-quality, fair care for children daily and during emergencies. Post-COVID-19, PPN has addressed pediatric care deficiencies by sharing resources and expertise.

The network includes 10 children's hospitals, four national partners, and experts from various fields. University Hospitals Rainbow Babies and Children's is one of the lead hub sites within the network and serves as a facilitator in carrying out the mission of PPN by providing guidance and resources to improve disaster response for pediatric populations.

That UH Rainbow initiatives will be driven by the ideas and innovations of the youth it aims to serve.





KIDS Rainbow Cohort Demographics























KIDS Rainbow Cohort Demographics






KIDS Rainbow Cohort 2 Demographics by City: Northeast Ohio
